Batter dipped potatoes deep fried golden brown

**Parmesan Chips - \$5.95**

Homemade potato chips deep fried and lightly dusted with Parmesan cheese with a side of bleu cheese dressing

**Chicken Wings - \$5.95**

A generous serving of chicken wings deep fried and served with dipping sauce

**Onion Rings - \$4.95**

A pile of sweet onion rings deep fried golden brown in a crispy breading

**Shrimp Basket - \$6.95**

Basket of bite-size shrimp deep fried golden brown served with cocktail sauce and lemon

**Chef Salad - \$6.95**

A combination of ham, turkey, Swiss and cheddar cheese, tomatoes, eggs, cucumbers and black olives on a bed of fresh salad greens



**Taco Salad - \$6.95**

Seasoned ground beef, diced tomatoes, diced onions, and cheddar cheese piled high on a bed of lettuce in an edible bowl. Salsa and sour cream served on the side

**Chicken Hawaiian Salad - \$7.95**

A blend of chicken, seasonal fresh fruit and toasted almonds make the foundation for this salad. Served on a bed of crisp salad greens

Two lightly breaded cod filets deep fried and served on a Kaiser Roll with tartar sauce  
Add a slice of cheese for \$.50

### **Veggie Burger - \$6.75**

Grilled veggie patty served on a Kaiser Roll with marinara sauce and  
topped off with a slice of mozzarella cheese

### **Classic Reuben Sandwich - \$6.95**

This classic sandwich is a stack of thinly sliced corned beef on rye bread,  
covered with homemade sauerkraut, topped with Swiss cheese and 1000 Island dressing
